These are short-term, paid, professional projects, typically ranging between 10-40 hours in duration. These projects are comprehensive across many industries and all departments.

For example, business students can find opportunities in sales, marketing, human resources, finance, etc. Micro-internships are posted throughout the course of the year. Students can apply to them whenever! These opportunities are great during breaks, such as winter or spring breaks.



You will want to create an account using your student e-mail.


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


Complete your profile



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

Each posting includes a description of the company and task, how long the opportunity is, how much you will be compensated, and whether the position is virtual or in person.

The application will ask you questions that you will need to complete. Your responses will count for your interview. Check and double check to spelling or grammatical errors.



TIPS & FAQ



Tip:

These opportunities are advanced projects with minimal supervision. Be sure to read the description of the posting in its entirety to have a further understanding of your responsibilities. You will be expected to complete the projects independently. Be honest with yourself and your competency in completing the task. The Internship Manager recommends microinternships for students who have taken at least 24 credits.

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<u>Can a micro-internship experience go on my resume?</u> Yes! You will certainly want to include this experience on your resume and portfolio. Be prepared to address what you learned and accomplished during your micro-internship in either a cover letter or interview. The Internship Manager is a great resource to support you in thinking through this further.

<u>How frequently should I check Parker Dewey?</u> If you're serious about wanting a micro-internship, you should check daily! These opportunities are competitive. Make sure to apply for an opportunity you're interested in as soon as possible.

<u>How do I know if the employer selected me as the micro-intern?</u> You will be notified via e-mail from Parker Dewey in the event you are selected. You will need to accept the offer and provide additional information in order to receive payment. Parker Dewey will also provide you resources to utilize throughout the course of your micro-intern.

<u>I'm an international student, can I still do a micro-internship?</u> Yes! International students are eligible through CPT, OPT, or a work visa. Be sure to confirm with the International Student Office on campus to ensure you're eligible to patriciate.

<u>How do I handle taxes for income earned through projects?</u> You are to report your earned income under self-employment income. If you earn more than \$600 from projects during the year, Parker Dewey will send you a 1099 to report on your tax return.
