

CDA Prep Course – Spring 2025

Program Description

Do you have the 120 clock hours for your CDA Credential but never submitted? Need to make your portfolio and schedule your observation and exam? This offering provides the final steps to obtain your CDA credential through binder completion.

The CDA is a national credential for practitioners working in a state licensed center/group home or family childcare facility. These sessions support students in the CDA application and verification process. Students must have proof of the 120 clock hours of training in the 13 competencies to be eligible for the sessions.

- The CDA is designed for students employed in the field and offers an entry-level credential that can lead to an associate degree in early childhood education.
- Students must complete 480 hours of supervised teaching in a licensed childcare facility.

Course Information: Live online and via Zoom Monday Evenings 7:00-8:30pm. Weekly class attendance through Zoom is required. In addition, students must complete weekly readings and written assignments as part of their coursework.

Dates: (15 weeks) Jan 27, Feb 3, 10, 17, 24, Mar 3, 10, 17, 24, 31, Apr 7, 14, 21, 28 and May 5.

Tuition: PHMC will fund tuition costs for this training. It is worth 45 clock hours of training.
